DALC are lobbying to give the choice between live and remote meetings moving forward.</p> <p>Clerk to send through a list of waste bins the Parish is responsible for to the Councillors.</p>																																																	
342/20	<p>Councillors Agenda Items</p> <p>The Council would like to thank George & Jean Wharmby for their input into getting the bus route 394 Glossop to Stepping Hill reinstated. The Chair of the Parish Council was also involved making several phone calls to key stakeholders to address this issue.</p> <p>We have received quotes for the Notice board proposed for Simmondley but are looking at other alternatives. Costs range from £750 - £1600. DCC have been contacted regarding the location for the board and to ask if planning permission is required.</p> <p>There are issues with flooding on the Simmondley trail under St Margaret's Rd Bridge. This is part of the Trans Pennine Trail. A member of the Council is due to meet with Jill Millward and will discuss the issue and report back at the next meeting.</p> <p>A Parishioner has requested a grit bin to be placed on the junction of Simmondley Rd and Storthmeadow Rd. Council to check where it could be located. Need to confirm if residents need to be authorised to use the bins.</p>
