DCC have been contacted to get their approval. DCC have started talking to British Rail about the proposed route of the Pennine Bridleway underneath Dinting Railway Arches. A decision is expected in either April or May 2020 about the feasibility of this route. Other alternative routes have been presented to DCC, which are far cheaper to develop, which pass through Charlesworth Parish utilising current footpaths and bridleways.
